And most importantly have some great safe racing!!

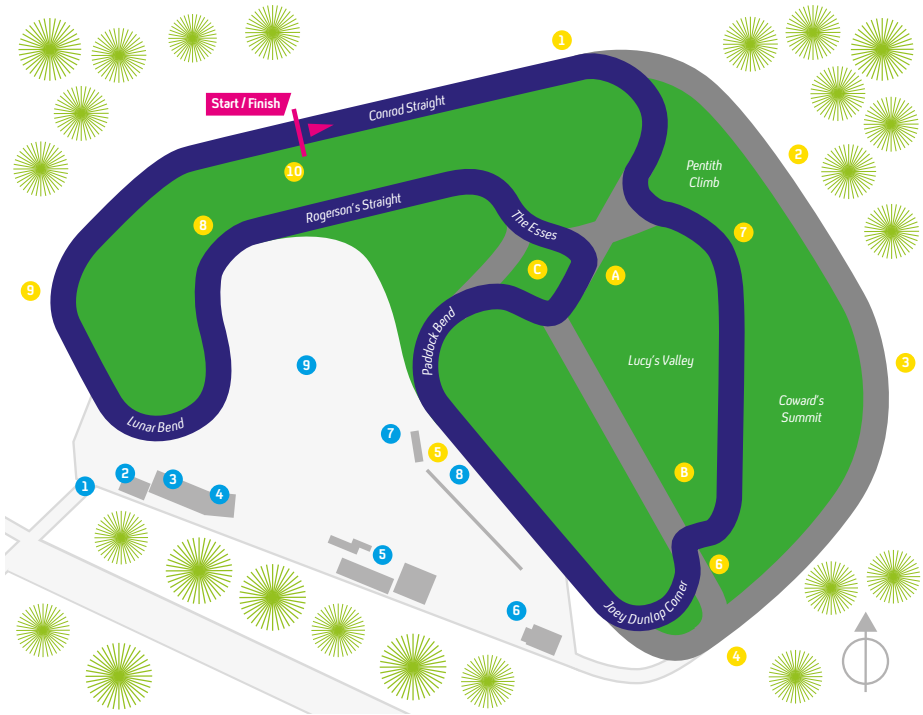

most likely to contain the least amount of Ethanol according to Esso UK's website.

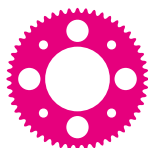
